Overflow Youth Midweek review

This is an opportunity to allow parents to review lessons their youth:

Sunday's Summary	The true Enemy: satan and his dark forces are who we actually fight against. Not People. Although people can fall prey to satan's temptations. We should recognize that they are not acting on their own accord. This does not mean they may not face consequences for their actions, or that we cannot be mad or sad. But we should also have compassion. Because our fight is not against them but the devil. And their sin is because they gave in to his temptations.

Discussion point 1:	Since God has given us the tools to fight against the enemy, how can we make sure we are prepared to use them daily. What are some practices we can do to make sure we use the tools he has given us?

Make sure to note. why they are doing or saying what they are. and instead of responding in anger Choose to practice the fruit of the Spirit.
